



SPIN-ON ASSEMBLY SERVICE INSTRUCTIONS

**** WARNING ****

RELIEVE ALL PRESSURE IN THE LINE BEFORE SERVICING FILTER ASSEMBLY

- 1) Follow all company & OSHA safety rules, such as wearing protective goggles and gloves, etc.
- 2) Disconnect the filter from the system.
- 3) Remove the old filter, while collecting all spilled fluid. Dispose of the old filter in accordance with local, state or federal regulations.
- 4) Apply a thin film of lubricant to the gasket of the new filter.
- 5) Screw new filter onto hub until the gasket makes contact with the head. Hand tighten another $\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{3}{4}$ turns **BY HAND ONLY**.
- 6) While system is re-pressurizing be sure to check for leaks.

NOTE:

Lubricant - Silicone is a recommended lubricant.

Storage - New elements should be stored in a dry environment to avoid rust/moisture problems
